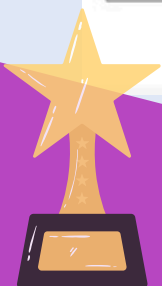

BHARATIYA BHASHA UTSAV: “Bahshayen Anek, Parantu Bhaav Ek, Vividhata mein Ekata, Ekata mein Vividhata, Bharatiya Bhashayen, Bharatiya Gyan Parampara aur Bharatiyata”, said Mrs. Kanchan Das, Assistant Teacher, **Manipal Public School (MPS), Katihar, Bihar**, in the morning assembly, when students applauded and welcomed the teachers on the podium to mark the day. According to the guidelines of the **Ministry of Education, Government of India** and the framework of **NCERT**, the esteemed **Manipal Public School (MPS), Katihar, Bihar**, has celebrated ‘Bharatiya Bhasha Utsav’ to commemorate the birth anniversary of **Mahakavi Subramania Bharati** on Monday, 11th December, 2023.

Mr. Pratap Toppo, Principal, MPS, Katihar, Bihar, highlighted the significance of ‘Bharatiya Bhasha Utsav’ giving momentum to the multi-linguistic theme of ‘**National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**’ in his address during the assembly. 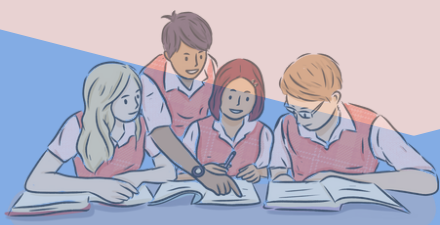

- Encourage them to share their experience and stories and inspire others;



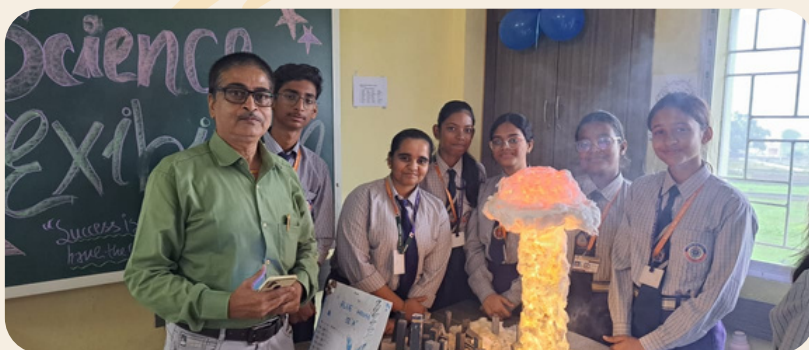
ANNUAL ARTS AND SCIENCE EXHIBITION

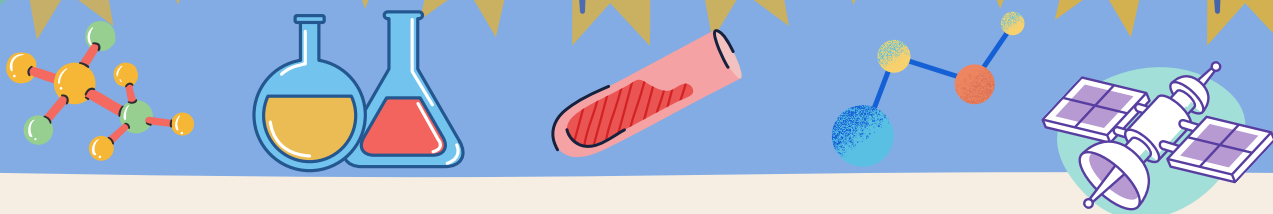

SPORTS DAY

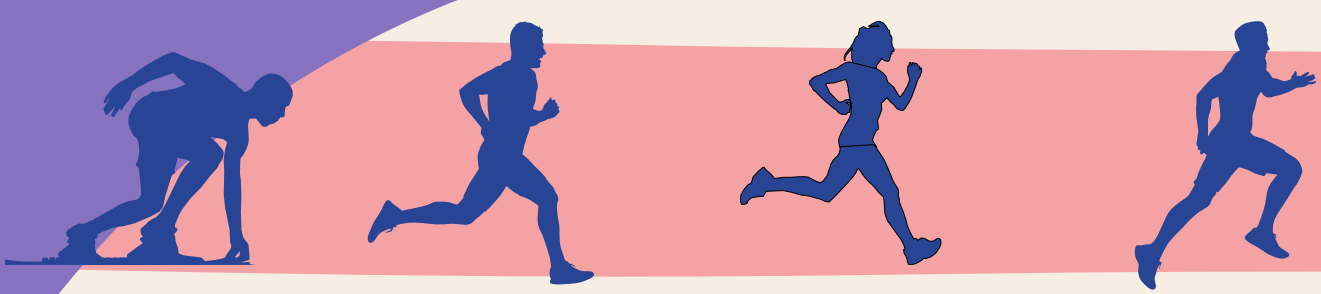

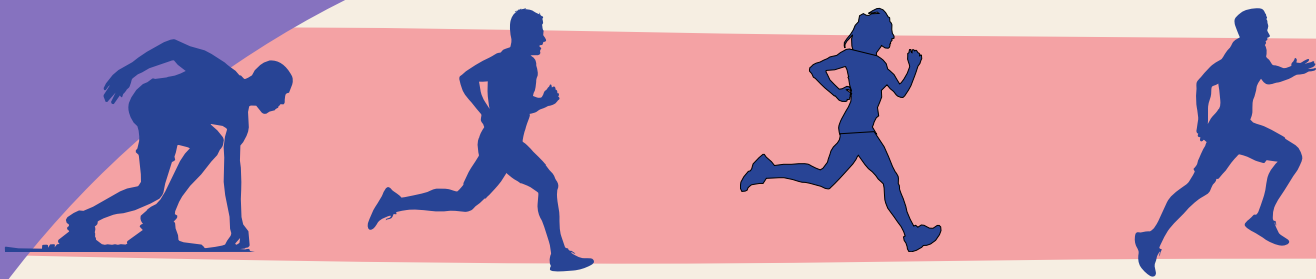
The primary wings celebrated the day on 22nd December, 2023. The day unfurled with splendid spectacles of march-past, musical drill-display.

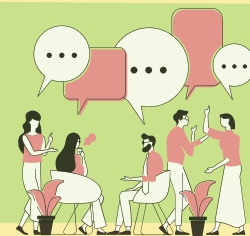
PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT
